ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

We require the following information prior to an interview:

- A psycho-educational evaluation current within three years which includes a WISC-III and achievement testing in the following areas:
- Reading, Language, Spelling, Written Language, Math
- If applicable, a current Individual Education Plan (IEP)
- A formal application returned with a \$75 application fee

Upon review of the above, if the Admissions Committee feels that the applicant would potentially benefit from Greenwood's program, you will be asked to submit the following:

- A Teacher Recommendation
- A Principal/Counselor Recommendation
- A Character Recommendation
- A Preliminary Health Form

Please submit any other information that will provide us with a more complete academic and historical profile of the applicant.

In addition, we require the following:

- A personal interview and tour of the school
- An overnight interview may be required
